Add vibrant splashes of color and beauty in the shaded areas of your landscape

Browallia - rich blue flowers, pop out like jewels against its bright green foliage

Caladium - tropical foliage plant grown for its spectacular, multicolored decorative leaves



Fuchsia - lovely hanging lantern-like flowers in magentas, pinks, purples, and whites

Hypoestes - lively little plant with spotted foliage that stands out especially well against other plants

Impatiens - all season-long, eye-popping color for shade areas

Lobelia - delicate sprays of intense and gorgeous tiny blue flowers

Plectranthus - beautiful variegated foliage with a graceful branching habit

Torenia - tiny snapdragon-like flower with delicate throats marked with a contrasting color

Many shade loving annuals will tolerate a good deal of morning sun as long as there is shade in the afternoon. Give your shade loving annuals **less than 4 hours of direct sun** per day.
