

# BROMELIAD

## *Flowering Period:*

Available year round. Flowerhead rises from central “vase” and can last several months. After flowering, the flowerhead will gradually begin to die; it is replaced by “pups” around the base of the “parent” plant. Pups can be removed from parent when about 1/3 the size of the parent, and potted in peat moss.

## *Light:*

Bright indirect light is ideal. Can take a few hours of direct sun in early morning or late afternoon. Protect from intense sun. Must have good air circulation.

## *Water:*

Compost must slightly dry between thorough soakings. Do not leave sitting in excess water nor repot into a larger container. Recommended to water in the central “vase,” and refresh this water often.
